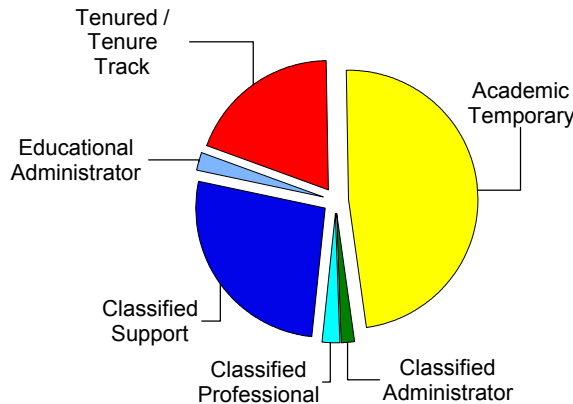

### Academic Temporary Breakdown

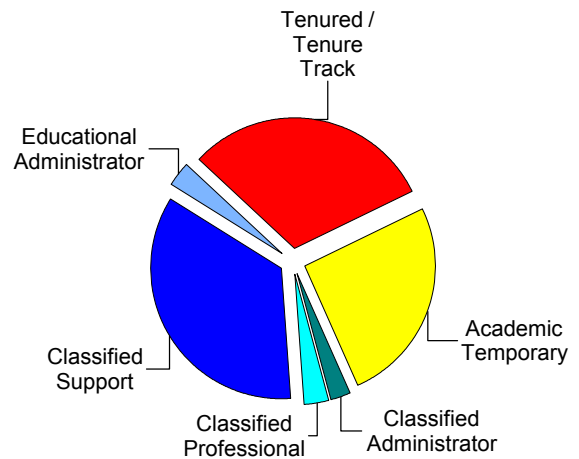
- 43,735 Count of academic temporaries with FTE less than 61%

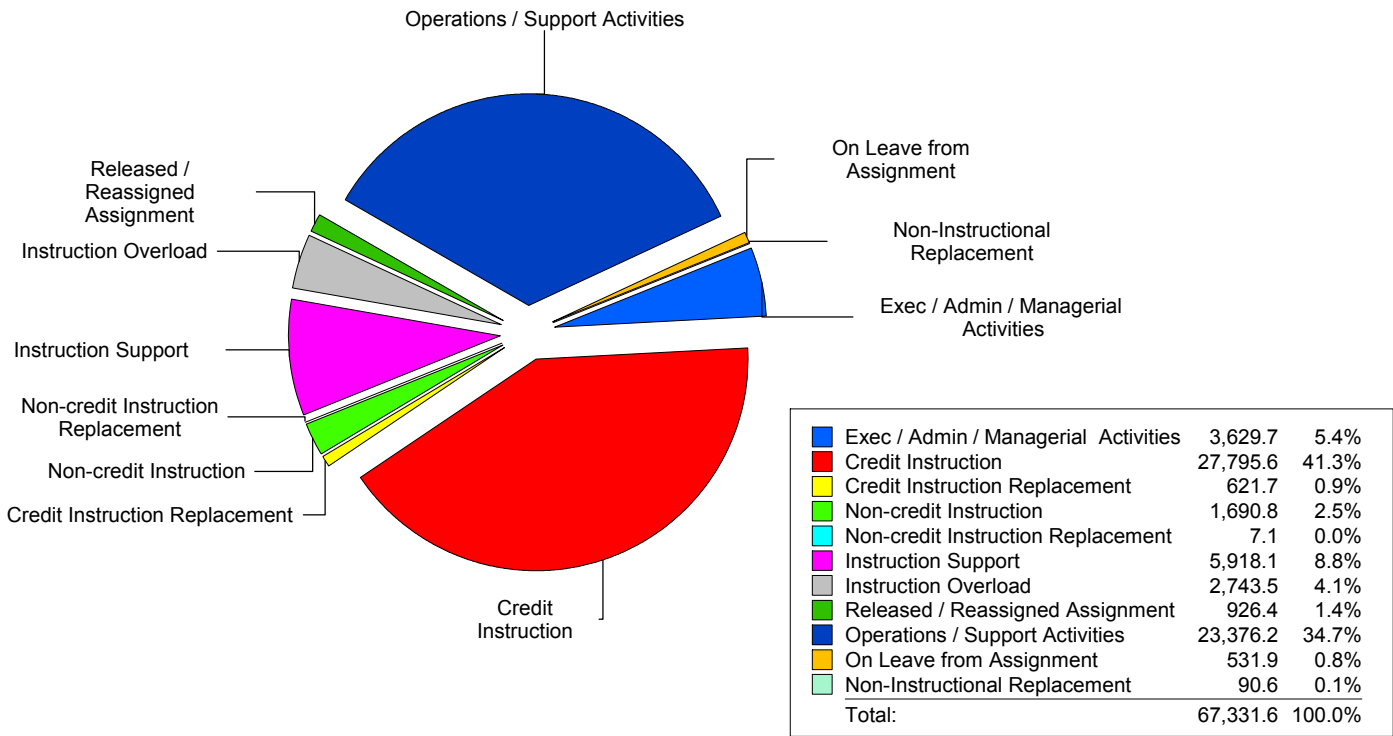

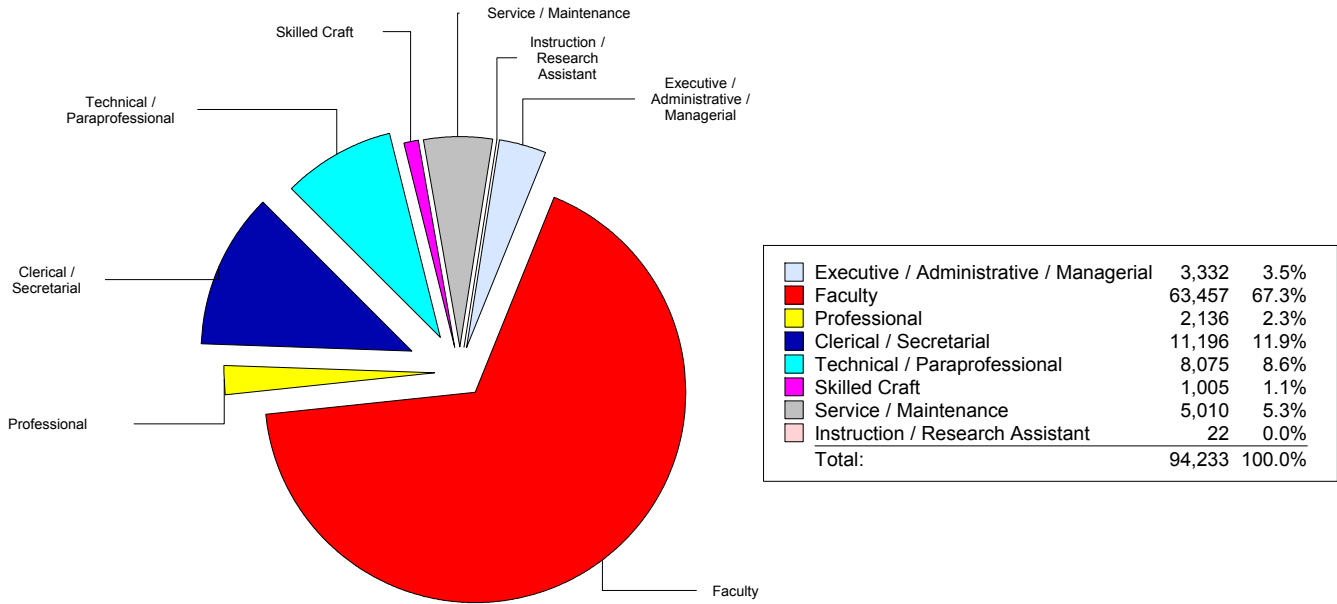

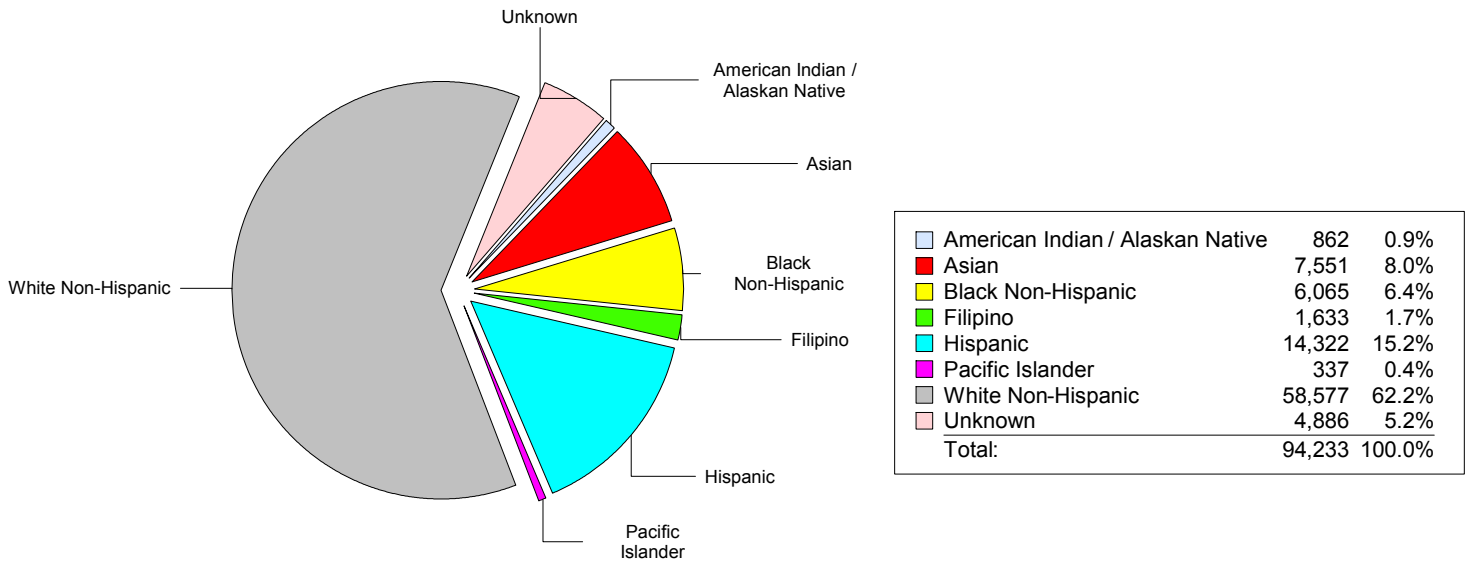

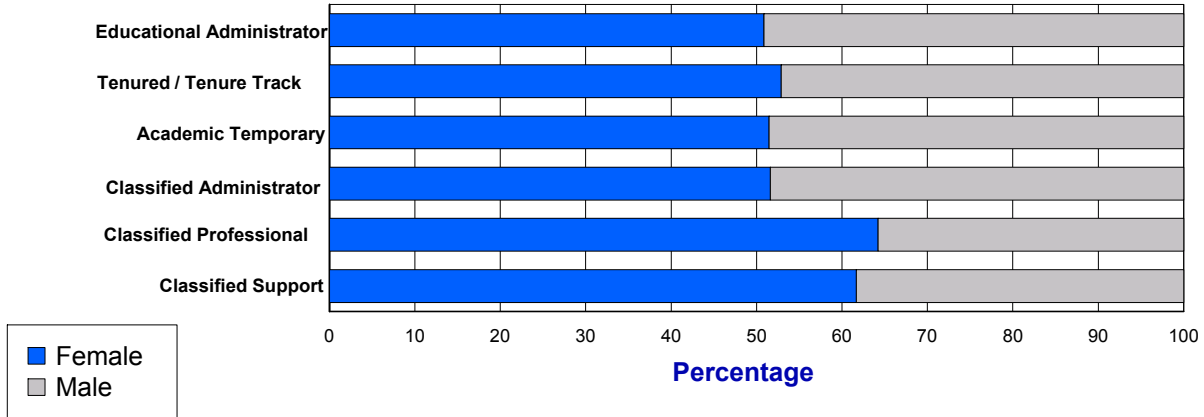

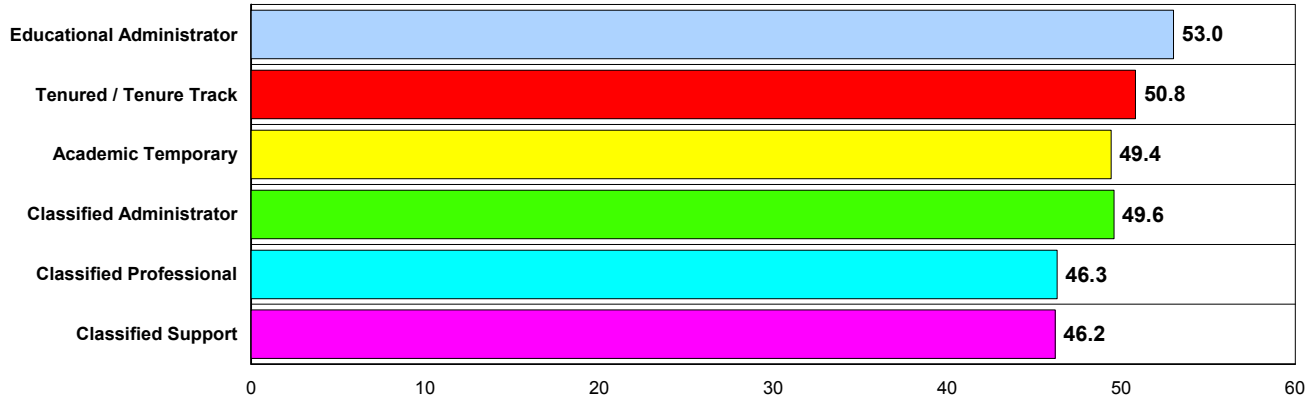

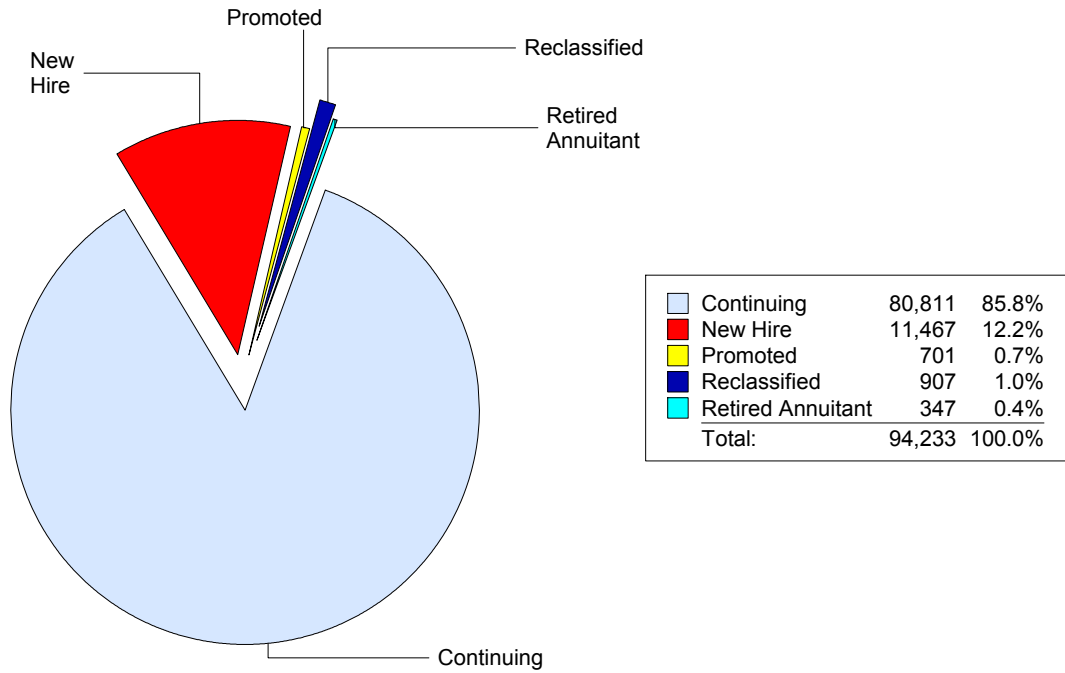

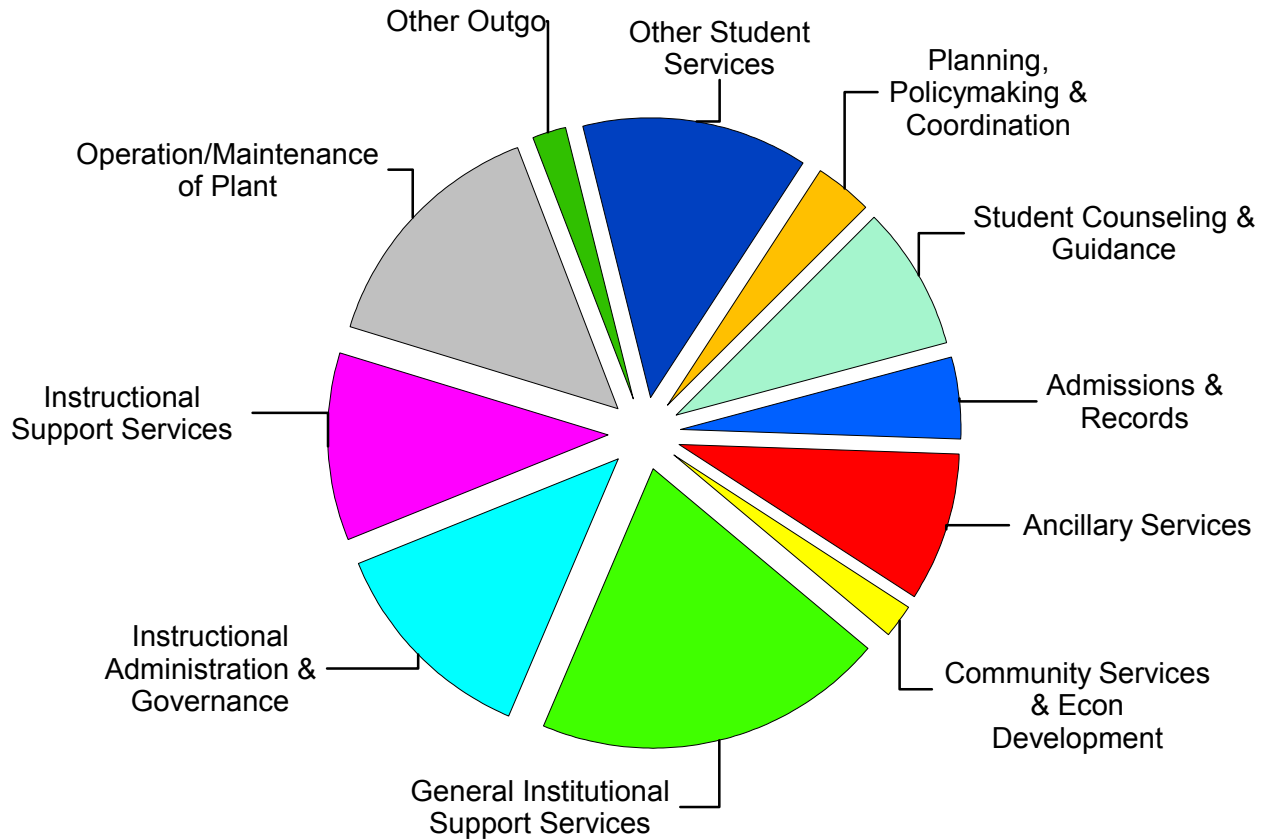
